## Call for Papers PAC 49

Dear 49<sup>th</sup> Algonquian Conference participant:

We are soliciting papers from presenters at the 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Algonquian Conference for publication in our annual volume. We encourage submissions from all areas of the field, and hope to receive papers from a wide range of subfields.

Papers should be submitted via email to **algonquianpapers@gmail.com**, with the subject line:

“Paper submission for PAC 49”

Papers should be submitted in **PDF format** only. We do not need a Word (or other format) document at this point.

Recall that we have moved to a single-blind reviewer system, so you do not need to omit your name from your paper. Please put your name below the title on the first page.

MSU Press puts constraints on the length of the volume, and so we must restrict the length of individual papers. Please limit your paper to at most **20 double-spaced pages**. We have set up a location on the PAC website to allow for materials that supplement published papers, which you can make use of if you have them and feel that they contribute to Algonquian studies.

All the formatting we need at this point (including all references, appendices, etc.) is:

- double-spaced throughout
- 12-point type
- 1.25-inch margins on the sides
- 1-inch margins on the top and bottom

There are no other style guidelines that you need to follow for the initial submission of your paper.

Our referees will be evaluating the manuscripts on considerations such as the following, which you should take into account as you prepare your submission:

- Does the paper significantly advance Algonquian studies within the disciplinary area it addresses?
- Are enough appropriate data presented to support the aims of the paper? Are they accurate, clearly presented, and properly sourced? If the data are linguistic, are they accurately transcribed and grammatically tenable?
- Are the theoretical framework and methodology suitable?

- Is the paper appropriately situated in prior research, and is that research appropriately and accurately cited?
- Is the paper clearly and coherently written and argued? Is its length appropriate for what it has to say? Space limitations for the volume encourage brevity. Can anything be safely omitted?

The deadline for submitting your manuscript is **January 31, 2018**.
